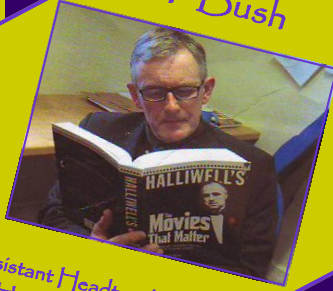

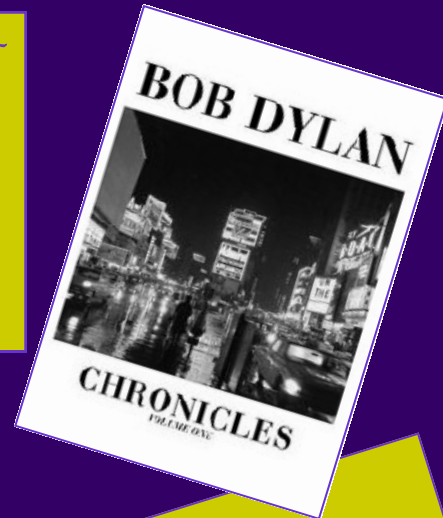
Can you remember when you first learnt to read and who taught you?

What yourite child and My favourite was Winnie Pooh, which read to me.

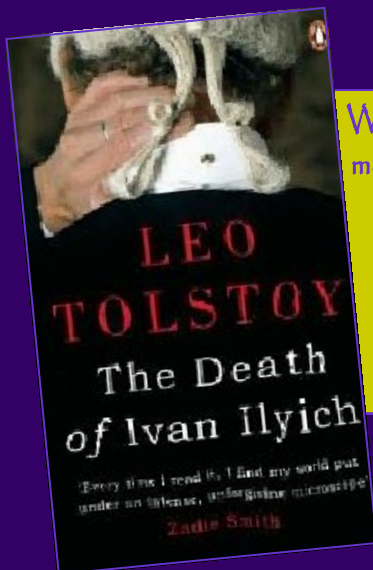

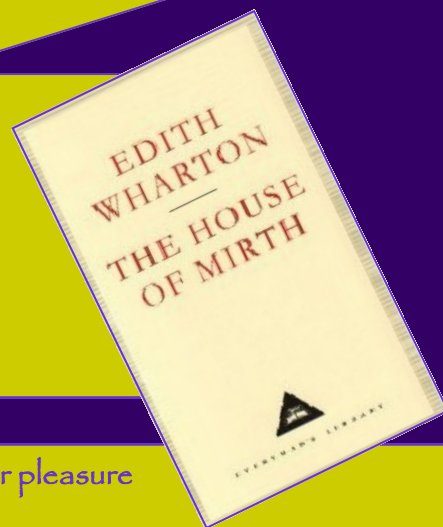
Which book has made you the happiest? *Chronicles Vol 1* by Bob Dylan, which is an autobiography
