What (if anything) are you reading at the moment?

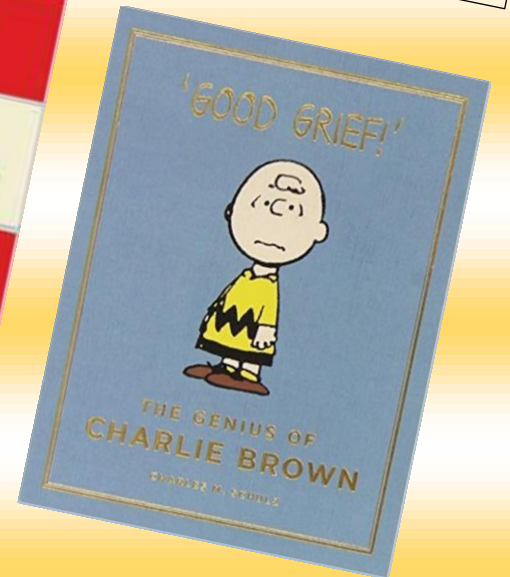
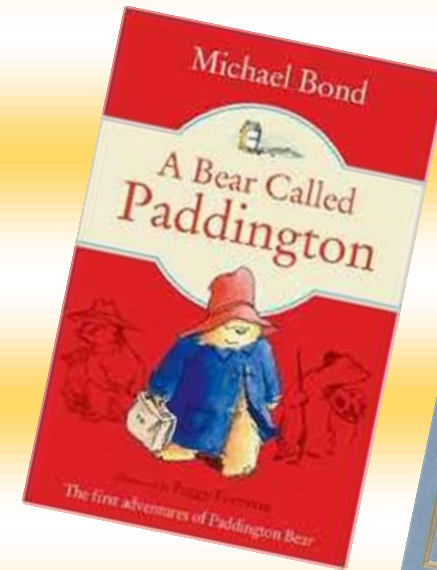
I am reading sporting success and mainly leadership books.

I particularly like crime fiction.

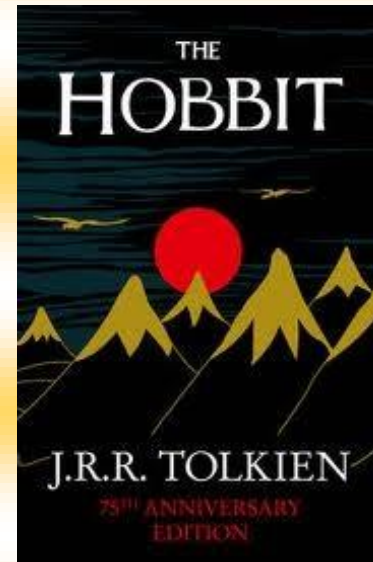
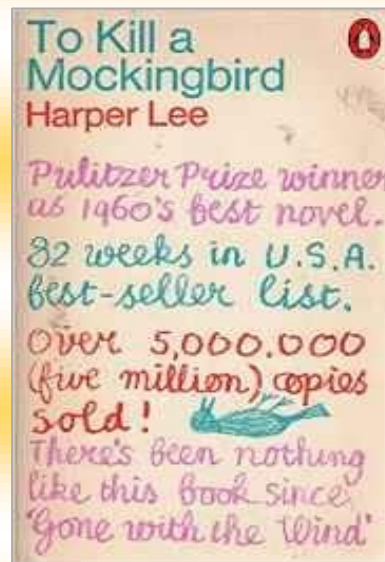
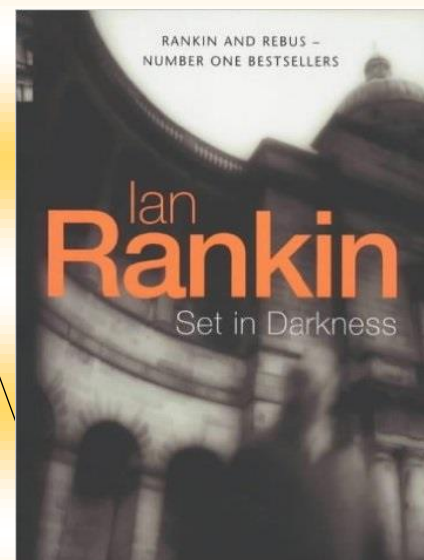
What three things do you admire in a book?
